Tie Principle:

Wherever two or more candidates have secured equal aggregate marks in IES/ISS Examination, 2025, the tie(s) have been resolved in accordance with the principles approved by the Commission as under:

Indian Economic Service :

- (i) If the marks in aggregate (Final Marks) are equal the candidate securing more marks in subject specific papers of written examination ("General Economics Paper-I, II, III and Indian Economics") plus marks of Personality Test put together will be ranked higher;
- (ii) If the marks at (i) above are equal candidates securing more marks in subject specific papers of written examination ("General Economics Paper-I, II, III and Indian Economics" put together) will be ranked higher; and
- (iii) Where marks at (i) & (ii) are also equal, candidates senior in age may be ranked higher

Indian Statistical Service :

- (i) If the marks in aggregate (Final Marks) are equal the candidate securing more marks in subject specific papers of written examination ("Statistics Paper-I, II, III & IV") plus marks of Personality Test put together will be ranked higher;
- (ii) If the marks at (i) above are equal candidates securing more marks in subject specific papers of written examination ("Statistics Paper-I, II, III & IV" put together) will be ranked higher; and
- (iii) If the marks at (i) & (ii) are also equal, candidates senior in age may be ranked higher.
